


2020 Basic Exterior Firefighting Operations w/Hazmat 1st Responder Ops, (BEFO plus FF1 part 1) or Bridge

The student will be provided with the training to support fire ground activities that arise before, during and after fire attack with respect to their exterior only classification. The student will be exposed to the knowledge and skills pertaining to: Fire, Tool and Scene Safety, Fire Behavior and Development, PPE and SCBA Practices (excluding donning and doffing of SCBA), Communication and Incident Management System (IMS) Principles, Fire Prevention and Investigation Principles, Fire Extinguishers, Hose Practices (excluding fire advancement and attack), Water Supply, Nozzles and Fire Streams, Ground Ladder Operations, Ropes and Knots. The course is derived from the Fire Fighter 1 curriculum.

The New York State OFPC Firefighter-1 certification will be delivered in two courses. All students will begin with the Basic Exterior Firefighting Operations and FF1 Part 1 and then progress into the SCBA/ Interior Firefighting Operations course if they are seeking to be trained as an Interior Structural Firefighter who will wear a self-contained breathing apparatus.
