Intermediate ICS for Expanding Incidents (I-300) (28-22-0300) - 170

Description: This course is designed to enable senior staff personnel to operate efficiently during an incident or event within the Incident Command System (ICS). This course focuses on management of expanding incidents and was developed under the leadership of the NWCG and complies with the NIMS/HSPD-5 requirements for Incident Command System training.

Objectives:

1. Describe how the National Incident Management System (NIMS) Command and Management component supports the management of expanding incidents.
2. Describe the incident/event management process for supervisors and expanding incidents as prescribed in the ICS.
3. Implement the incident management process on a simulated Type 3 incident.
4. Develop an Incident Action Plan for a simulated incident.

Designed for: Individuals who may assume a supervisory/management role in expanding (Type 3) incidents. Persons likely to assume these ICS supervisory positions would include Emergency Management, Fire Service, Law Enforcement, EMS, Healthcare, Education, Military, & Volunteer organizations active in disaster. An Introduction to the National Incident Management System (IS-700) (11-18-0700)
National Response Framework, an Introduction (IS-800) (11-18-0800)
