- COURSE REQUIREMENTS:**
- Resident Tuition \$700.00\*\* (7 Credits for original EMT students only)  
\*\*The course's tuition will be paid by the state for those meeting the eligibility requirements (Paid professional ambulance technicians and/or volunteer fire and ambulance personnel - those actively working with a fire department or other EMS agency in Chautauqua/Cattaraugus County have priority over other applicants and the tuition will be paid by the state).
  - Non-Resident Tuition: If you have not resided in New York State for one year, you will be charged non-resident tuition (approximately \$1400).
  - Recertification Tuition: Those taking the course for recertification will not receive college credits and tuition will be paid by the state for those meeting the eligibility requirements. Others will be charged \$300.00.

A CPR text will be available for purchase during class time

  - Attendance All students must attend all sessions. Any missed classes must be made up.
  - Academics Students must pass all aspects of the course to be eligible to sit for the state certifying exam.
  - Physical Condition Some EMT training is strenuous. Applicants should consult their physician if conditions exist that may prevent them from full participation.
  - Proof of Immunizations Students MUST provide proof of immunization from Rubella and Rubeola, a negative TB test and a qualifying physical exam to both the college health center and the hospital where they will be doing observation time. More will be explained the first class night.

**ELIGIBILITY:**

Applicants must be:

- ~~At least 18 years of age before December 16, 2010 (before the State Exam Date).~~
- Physically able to function as an EMT, meeting ADA requirements
- Able to read at least at the 11<sup>th</sup> high school grade level
- Those with criminal convictions of any type may not be allowed to be certified, pending investigation by the DOH
- Paid professional ambulance technicians and/or volunteer fire and ambulance personnel (those actively working with a fire department or other EMS agency in Chautauqua/Cattaraugus County) have priority over other applicants

**PREREQUISITES:**

- There are no academic prerequisites; however the college reserves the right to exclude students who have previously been declared academically ineligible, or those who are indebted to the college. When there are more than 35 applications, enrollment may be assigned on a priority basis per guidelines established by the Chautauqua County EMS Council. If more than two persons from one department have applied, the Chief of the department shall rank them in order of priority.
- The state Department of health covers the tuition only, of those applicants who are actively working with a New York State EMS Squad. All other New York State residents will be charged the resident tuition. Those not residing within New York State for at least six months will be charged the Non-resident 7 credit hour tuition rate set for that semester.
- Students should plan on attending the first class session, but will be notified by mail prior to August 11, 2010 as to whether they were accepted into the course.

 (Note: 5 Saturday classes are mandatory – 9/11, 10/16, 10/30, 11/6, 12/4)  
**Location:** Fredonia Fire Hall (Enter by back door)  
**Fee:** \$575 plus texts (Pay only for texts if you are affiliated with a local EMS agency)  
**Cost of texts:** \$99 + tax (textbook/workbook package - *Emergency Care*, 11<sup>th</sup> edition)  
 Textbooks must be paid for in advance to Lifelong Learning and Special Programs (checks payable to SUNY Fredonia). They will be available, on site, on the first night of class.

Offered in conjunction with the New York State Department of Health, the course includes basic first aid information, cardiovascular emergency, shock, fractures, bleeding, defibrillation and special problems in triage and extrication. Written and practical exams are included.

### Requirements:

- Participants must be at least 18 years of age.
- As regulated by the New York State Department of Health, documentation of a completed physical examination, ppd (Mantoux) skin test for tuberculosis and immunizations is required for hospital observations. This is due by the 3<sup>rd</sup> class.
- Attendance at all sessions is mandatory.

Register now! Seats are limited and the course fills quickly. Enrollment will be limited on a priority basis set forth by the New York State Department of Health guidelines. If you are being sponsored by a local agency, please note the agency's name, address, and contact person and attach it to your registration form below – *all textbook fees are due at the time of registration – agencies must provide their tax exempt ST-119.1 form*. Further, if the sponsored participant withdraws from or drops the class, or is dropped for not complying with attendance requirements, the agency will be responsible for paying SUNY Fredonia one-half of the NYS Department of Health, Bureau of EMS course reimbursement rate. Registration forms are due by Thursday, August 19, 2010.

Participants may earn 4 SUNY Fredonia credit hours for this course. Please contact Lifelong Learning and Special Programs prior to August 23 to apply. The last day to apply for college credit (add a course) is August 31, 2010.

**Any current or former EMT (not MET) is eligible to take the refresher course regardless of how many years since their EMT certification expired.**

**Attendance at course sessions is based on challenge written test and challenge practical skill stations for those students selecting this option. All students who are active in EMS are encouraged to try and challenge.**

The first class session will encompass introduction and registration items as well as a review of the significant changes over the past three years. A schedule for the challenge exams and regular classes will then be handed out.

Enrollment will be limited and students will be accepted on a priority basis as established by the New York State Health Department. Members of volunteer agencies, municipal services, and paid ambulance services will have priority on a first registered basis, if needed.

**\*\*Students who have any misdemeanor or felony convictions in their past, or those currently under charges may be denied certification by the state, or may be delayed taking the state exam.**
